All 75 artworks submitted to SHARE by our district will be exhibited at Say Sí, March 24-27, 2010. Students and their families will be invited to a viewing on March 24 from 5:30 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. A jury will select 100 works from the 2010 SHARE EXHIBITION to become part of the permanent collection at the Child Guidance Center of San Antonio, which provides quality outpatient mental health care to Bexar County children and adolescents regardless of family income level. The SHARE collection will enhance the lives of the children through communication in its simplest. By relating to emotions, moods and feelings, art can be helpful in the healing process. Displaying children's artwork in a children's clinic will appeal and connect with the children's human emotions by arousing aesthetic or moral feelings. Art not placed in the permanent collection will be returned to you in April, along with Certificates of Merit to present to those students. You will also receive a list of selected artworks.
